

TECHNOLOGY MUSEUM

Ancient Greek technology: A unique exhibition referring to the prehistoric period, until the Hellenistic and Byzantine period. The exhibition features more than 70 exact replicas of machines that have marked people's lives and set the cultural context as well.

Transportation technology: This part of the museum features car models that marked the history of automobile. The exhibition consists of 5 main thematic areas, based on 5 top car models of the 20th century: mass production, city and environment, technological advances, design and society and speed.

Techno-park: An interactive exhibition, where you can actively participate and learn while having fun. It includes 50 exhibits concerning a variety of scientific topics, like electricity, magnetism, vision, mechanics, etc.

TEMPORARY SHADOW ART EXHIBITION GENESIS FROM 1/11

What we see isn't always what we're looking at. Impressive shadows are created by mysterious shapeless sculptures, leading you to a place where light "draws" on walls. See things that cannot be seen in this visual exhibition.

PLANETARIUM (for adults and children 5 and older)

Two small pieces of glass: The show explores the evolution of telescope's technology, from Galileo's experiments to the HST and beyond. **Duration: 25'**

Out There: What we have found exploring the Universe so far has surpassed even our wildest expectations. A huge diversity of worlds is out there, waiting to be discovered. **Duration: 35'**

The Zula Patrol 2: An animated film suitable for younger children. Learn about the formation and development of Planet Earth, and the life forms who call it home. **Duration: 25'**

From Earth to the Universe: This stunning voyage through space and time conveys the Universe revealed to us by science. **Duration: 35'**

COSMOTHEATER (for adults and children 5 and older)

Dream Big (3D): The movie celebrates the human ingenuity behind engineering marvels, and reveals the heart that drives engineers to create better lives for us all. **Duration: 40'**

Dinosaurs – The Giants of Patagonia (3D): Dinosaurs come to life before our eyes, on the gigantic screen of the Cosmotheater. **Duration: 40'**

Journey to Space (3D): The movie is a celebration of the Space Shuttle programme and what it contributed to the next chapter in human space exploration. **Duration: 40'**

SIMULATOR 3D (for adults and children 7 and older, at least 1.20m tall)

Moon Thunder (3D): Join our astronaut crew in this thrilling escape from the collapsing surroundings of a moon base. Will you reach the escape pod in time? **Duration: 5'**

Catacombs (3D): Paris 1850. On a rainy night you find shelter into its dark Catacombs. Find out if you can keep your cool in this thrilling experience. **Duration: 5'**
