

TECHNOLOGY MUSEUM



Ancient Greek technology

A unique exhibition referring to the prehistoric period, until the Hellenistic and Byzantine period. The exhibition features more than 70 exact replicas of machines that have marked people's lives and set the cultural context as well.



Transportation technology

This part of the museum features car models that marked the history of automobile. The exhibition consists of 5 main thematic areas, based on 5 top car models of the 20th century: mass production, city and environment, technological advances, design and society and speed.

The group must arrive at NOESIS 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled activity.
