TECHNOLOGY MUSEUM

Ancient Greek technology: A unique exhibition referring to the prehistoric period, until the Hellenistic and Byzantine period. The exhibition features more than 70 exact replicas of machines that have marked people's lives and have set the cultural context, as well.

Transportation technology: This part of the museum features car models that marked the history of automobile. The exhibition consists of 5 main thematic areas, based on 5 top car models of the 20th century: mass production, city and environment, technological advances, design and society and speed.

Techno-park: An interactive exhibition, where you will actively participate and learn while having fun. It includes 50 exhibits, concerning a variety of scientific topics, like electricity, magnetism, vision, mechanics, etc.

TEMPORARY EXHIBITION CONNECTED

The possibilities offered by modern technology have radically changed our daily life. "Connected" tries to detect the technological advancements that led to this new reality, point out perspectives, and ask questions about opportunities and dangers that arise.

PLANETARIUM (for adults and children 5 and older)

Magic Globe: A little girl Mia walks into an intrigue of her uncle who wants to get rid of the world's seasons. She realizes the consequences of what they are going to do, but Edmund doesn't want to let the plan go. **Duration: 40'**

From Earth to the Universe: This stunning voyage through space and time conveys the Universe revealed to us by science. **Duration: 35'**

Space Opera: An artistic, philosophic, scientific and cinematic experience all at the same time and indeed a unique experience of its kind. **Duration: 40'**

COSMOTHEATER (for adults and children 5 and older)

Ocean Odyssey (3D): The great ocean currents are the arteries and veins of Planet Earth. This is the story of one particularly fascinating flow - the East Australian Current, a massive oceanic river that stretches the length of Australia's east coast.. **Duration: 40'**

Dinosaurs – The Giants of Patagonia (3D): Dinosaurs come to life before our eyes, on the gigantic screen of the Cosmotheater. **Duration: 40'**

SIMULATOR 3D (for adults and children 7 and older, at least 1.20m tall)

Moon Thunder (3D): Join our astronaut crew in this thrilling escape from the collapsing surroundings of the moon base. Will you reach the escape pod in time? **Duration: 5'**

Great Wall of China (3D): This simulator show displays one of the world's miracles: the Great Wall of China. **Duration: 5'**
